

The school aims at imparting the usage of computers as a tool rather than a subject. The school has an internet facility, enabling the students to access global network as and when required.




❖ LIBRARY:



Beyond academics.....

Music boosts fine motor skills, promotes memory and nurtures critical-thinking. Our school offers Guitar and Keyboard classes that are conducted by our expert musician Mr. Darryl Tone. He has several years of experience in playing and teaching music and is an expert in instructing students in the theory of general music, singing as well as playing the guitar and keyboard.



Sports being a major part of the curriculum, our school offers coaching for various sports activities like badminton and table tennis, after regular school hours wherein the students get extra time and training to excel in a sport of their preference. Badminton has many benefits. It strengthens muscles, enhances reflexes and motor coordination, increases flexibility, improves balance and also develops the physical and cognitive skills. Table tennis is a popular indoor sport world wide. It is not just a game, but a physically demanding sport that requires excellent eye-hand coordination and balance. It also provides a great aerobic workout. It demands strategic thinking, concentration and quick decision making skills. To sum up, these sports activities not only help students stay healthy but also help to improve their emotional fitness which is a necessity in today's world.



The school offers football coaching for the following age groups: Under 8, Under 10, Under 12, Under 14 and Under 16. The coaching is conducted by professional coaches, and students who are identified as having a flair for the sport are selected to represent the school in interschool tournaments.



STREET PLAY

It was for the very first time that the students of St. Francis School (CISCE), in a novel initiative, organised a street play in order to educate the public on the dangers of media addiction.

The play titled 'Media Se Nahi, Zindagi Se Judiye' was enacted by a few talented students of the Secondary Section of our school on Saturday 21st October, 2023 near the 'I ♥ I.C.' Signage on Road No. 2 in I.C. Colony, Borivali (West).

The Street Play commenced at 10 a.m. sharp with a trumpet fanfare to announce the start of the play as well as to invite pedestrians to watch the play.

Twenty-five students from grades 6 to 9 were trained for the performance across a span of three months.

A team of dedicated teachers put in their best effort and worked as a team to bring out the maximum potential of the performing cast of actors.

The 15 minute performance powerfully depicted the detrimental effects of being addicted to social media and successfully got across the message that it intended to convey.

The students put up a rip-roaring performance with their strong stage presence.

Right from shouting out powerful slogans on media addiction to aptly depicting ordinary lives of people, the students successfully conveyed the message of the need to mindfully use social media within limits.

The play also emphasized how addiction to Instagram can be a real problem for some teens today. It further stressed on excessive gaming habits.

Two time periods (1980s and 2023) were well depicted to make clear how social media affected our lives back then versus now.

The Street play reinforced the fact that any kind of media addiction results in neglecting hobbies or responsibilities and one can face a range of negative consequences including social isolation, poor academic/work performance, and mental health problems such as anxiety and depression.

Meaningful and creative placards were also used to create a stronger impact and make the message as clear as possible.

In fact the people who gathered to watch were so enthralled by the concept and the performance that the students were asked to repeat the performance.

In Conclusion, the message that went out was that media addictions are real and one needs to be mindful of their use without affecting the quality of their lives.

I would like to take this opportunity on behalf of the team to thank our Principal, Brother Wilfred Monteiro for giving us this opportunity to explore new possibilities as educators thus creating awareness and educating the masses through this novel initiative of a street play.
